About Clotamin

Warfarin and Vitamin K

Because it doesn't contain vitamin k, Clotamin® can be taken with warfarin without affecting international normalized ratio (INR) levels. Warfarin is the most prescribed blood thinning medication in North America and is also known under the brand names of Coumadin®, Jantoven®, Marevan®, and Waran®. Warfarin therapy reduces the formation of blood clots, which is important in the prevention of heart attacks, strokes, and blockage of major veins and arteries.

Strict Nutritional Guidelines

People who are prescribed blood thinners are required to follow strict nutritional guidelines in order to maintain healthy International Normalized Ratio (INR) levels. The most significant of these guidelines is the consumption of a consistent amount of vitamin k in their diet. Clotamin was designed without vitamin k so it will not affect warfarin treatment and INR levels and, at the same time, provide all the other essential daily vitamins and nutrients of a complete multivitamin.
